



NRP COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course has been designed to teach an evidence-based approach to resuscitation of the newborn. The causes, prevention, and management of mild to severe neonatal asphyxia are carefully explained so that health professionals may develop optimal knowledge and skill in resuscitation. Approximately 10% of all newborns will need some type of resuscitation.

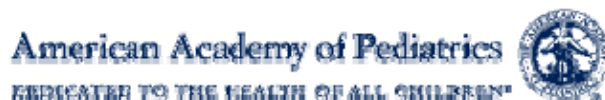
